

CPT Codes Authorized for Use by D.O.M.s in New Mexico – 2011

This document provides information about the statutorily authorized scope of practice for different categories of doctors of oriental medicine (D.O.M.s) in New Mexico, as expressed in the Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) coding system published by the American Medical Association. These CPT codes change annually and sometimes more often, so these lists change periodically as well. The scope of practice of D.O.M.s may additionally include services that are not described in the AMA CPT coding system. The lists of CPT codes in this document include the following:

List 1 – CPT Codes for all D.O.M.s

List 2 – Additional CPT Codes for D.O.M.s Board Certified in Basic Injection Therapy

List 3 – Additional CPT Codes for D.O.M.s Board Certified in Injection Therapy

List 4 – Additional CPT Codes for D.O.M.s Board Certified in Intravenous Therapy

List 5 – Additional CPT Codes for D.O.M.s Board Certified in Bioidentical Hormone Therapy

The oriental medical services identified in the following **List 1 – CPT Codes for all D.O.M.s** are within the scope of practice of all D.O.M.s in New Mexico who are licensed by the Board of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine. The scope of practice for all such D.O.M.s is defined in the New Mexico Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine Practice Act at 61-14A-3 NMSA 1978 and in the rules of the Board of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine at 16.2.2 NMAC.

The oriental medical services identified in the following **CPT Code List 2 – Basic Injection Therapy, CPT Code List 3 – Injection Therapy, CPT Code List 4 – Intravenous Therapy and CPT Code List 5 – Bioidentical Hormone Therapy** are within the scope of practice of a D.O.M. in New Mexico who is board certified in the related oriental medicine expanded practice category or categories by the Board of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine. The scope of practice for all such D.O.M.s who are Board certified in oriental medicine expanded practice is defined in New Mexico Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine Practice Act at 61-14A-8.1 NMSA 1978 and in the rules of the Board of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine at 16.2.18 NMAC and 16.2.20 NMAC. All services performed by all D.O.M.s are, by statute, oriental medical services (61-14A-3.E, NMSA 1978).

A D.O.M. who is board certified for expanded practice may be board certified in one or more of four categories. Currently, a D.O.M. whose license number includes the designation Rx1 is Board Certified in Basic Injection Therapy and a D.O.M. whose license number includes the designation Rx2 is Board Certified in all expanded practice categories of Injection Therapy, Intravenous Therapy and Bioidentical Hormone Therapy. Details of these category designations may be found in the rules of the Board of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine at 16.2.19.16 NMAC.

Doctors of oriental medicine in New Mexico who are Board Certified in Basic Injection Therapy by the Board of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine may perform the oriental medical services identified by the CPT codes in the above **List 1 – CPT Codes for all D.O.M.s**, as well as the following oriental medical services identified by the CPT codes in this **List 2 – Additional CPT Codes for D.O.M.s Board Certified in Basic Injection Therapy**. These doctors of oriental medicine may perform intradermal, intramuscular and subcutaneous injections (16.2.20.8.F (1) NMAC).

Doctors of oriental medicine in New Mexico who are Board Certified in Injection Therapy by the Board of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine may perform the oriental medical services identified by the CPT codes in the above **List 1 – CPT Codes for all D.O.M.s**, as well as the following oriental medical services identified by the CPT codes in this **List 3 – Additional CPT Codes for D.O.M.s Board Certified in Injection Therapy**. These doctors of oriental medicine may perform all non-epidural, non intrathecal injections (16.2.20.8.F (2) (b) NMAC).
